Course Outcomes

Semester I

Core Course-1A:

CO 5. In this semester they start to know about modern literary theories to analyse this stories.

CO 1. They read some selected Bengali essay.

CO 3. They read some selected modern poetry by some modern poet.

CO 4. And they gain knowledge about modern literature.

CO 5. They also read some modern literary theories to critic the poetry.

CO 6. They also learn to take lesion difference between Rabindra-poetry and modern poetry.

Skill Enhancement Course-2:

CO 1. Their writing skills being increased throughout the semester.

CO 2. Also they acquire knowledge to write letters, reports and essays.

CO 3. They also learn to structure of Bengali sentence.

CO 4. They learn how to write a grammatically correct sentence.

Semester V

Discipline Specific Elective Course-1A:

CO 1. They learn in this course about history of modern literature.

Semester VI
