PREFACE & OVERVIEW

It was 4th January, 1959. The place was Subhasnagar, Hooghly. Far from the madding crowd, far from the din and bustle of town and city, it was here amidst the lush verdancy of bounteous nature that the seed of this college was sown. **Dr. Radha Krishna Pal**, the great social reformer and M.L.A., along with some local academic-minded people, took great pains to sow this tiny academic seed and helped to bring it up with assiduous care. It was named after the parents of our most revered Chief-Minister, late **Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy** who laid the foundation - stone of the college. That tiny seed has now grown into a mighty tree, providing academic shelter to the pupils of five adjoining districts : Hooghly, Midnapur, Burdwan, Bankura and Purulia. Now our college offers 19 Honours Courses & 20 General courses to our learners. The college had gradually reinforced its infrastructural potentiality with as many as nine buildings and looks forward to introducing new courses that will cater to the demands of the new generations of learners.

VISION OF THE COLLEGE

In a country like India, with the majority of its population living in rural regions, participation of rural students in the process of nation-building is essential. Aghorekamini Prakashchandra Mahavidyalaya strives to become a pre-eminent rural college of the country fostering intellect, creativity and character in this section of students; thus conditioning them to become the leaders of the society and builders of the nation.

The rural location of the college enables it to cater to the needs of students, mostly first generation learners, belonging to economically handicapped families. Our mission is to convert these raw inputs into socially, intellectually and emotionally trained human capital.

- To provide scope and facilities for higher education to all sections of people in the society.
- To develop ideal condition for innovation, development of scientific aptitude and rational thinking.
- To prepare students for competitive examinations in order to help them make the most of job opportunities in future.
- To eradicate all kinds of unfair discrimination to encourage female students, students of backward classes and minority groups to help them march forward in the society.

- To motivate all sections of students to take an active part in NCC, NSS, games and sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities.
- To nurture human qualities like discipline on the campus, fellow-feeling, secularism, patriotism, sense of national integration and eco-friendly attitude among students.
- To inculcate a sense of social responsibility in students that is indispensable for building a strong nation.

LOGO

The college possesses a unique logo. The logo displays a sun against the vast horizon, rising from the depth of the turbulent waves. The vast horizon stands for the expanse of our aspirations and goals. The turbulent waves stand for our energy and enthusiasm for work. It is only through constant and consistent hard work that we realise our dreams. The rising sun stands for the enlightenment. The motto of our college enshrined within our logo is "Yad bhadram tanna a suva", meaning" Let whatever is benign descend on all of us".

INFRASTRUCTURE

Our infrastructure comprises Buildings, Hostels, Laboratories, Library, Canteens, Seminar Room, Virtual Class Room, Sports facility etc..

BUILDINGS : At present we have nine major buildings named as different bhavans.

PRASHASHANIK BHAVAN : It is the oldest building of our college and is meant chiefly for administrative function. Besides, the Principal's Office, the Computer Room, Staff Canteen, Girls' Common Room, NCC Office, Store Room, NSS Office, Charitable Homoeopathy Dispensary, the Teachers' Room, the Departmental Room, Bursar's Office, the laboratories of Physics & Chemistry are located within this building.

BANIJYA BHAVAN : It is also one of the oldest buildings of our college. Two store rooms, five classrooms & the Seminar Hall are there within this building.

KALA BHAVAN : It is a large building having eight classrooms. This building is utilised solely for pedagogical purposes.

VIJNAN BHAVAN : This building is used mainly for pedagogical purposes & meets the demands of the increasing pressure of learners. On the 2nd floor, the laboratories of Geography, Environmental Science, Zoology & Botany are located. In a part of the 1st floor there are the laboratories of Nutrition & Geography.

PATHA BHAVAN : This building is used chiefly for further study. The College library, the reading rooms for teachers and students and two class rooms are housed in this building.

SANSKRITI BHAVAN : It is a newly constructed building with aid from the MPLAD Fund. This building is used for various cultural programmes. The laboratories of Music, Physical Education, Multi-Gym and Cheap Canteen for Students are located within this building.

CHHATRA SANSAD BHAVAN : It is also a newly constructed building. It is mainly used for various cultural programmes conducted by the members of the Students' Union. The Students' Common Room & the Students' Union Office are there within this building.

NEW ADMINISTRATIVE CUM CLASSROOM BUILDING : It is under construction and at present in the final stage of completion.

NEW INDOOR SPORTS INFRASTRUCTURE : It is under construction and work is progressing steadily.

Library : The college has a large library equipped with more than 25000 books and several journals. Each student is entitled to borrow two books at a time. Besides, question papers and model questions are also available in the library. It also keeps career guidance magazines such as Karmakshetra, Karmasangsthan, Jibika Dishari etc. Apart from the printed journals our library is now registered for the INFLIBNET N-List programme through which we can access more than 2100 e-journals and 51000 e-books. The Lending Service is available from 10-30 a.m. to 3-00 p.m. To access the library services the students must bring their library cards along with them. The lending process has been computerised recently.

READING ROOM : There are separate Reading Rooms for teachers and students. The Reading Rooms are equipped with books, periodicals and journals of different disciplines that keep one abreast of the recent developments in the academic scenario.

HOSTEL FACILITIES : The College provides hostel facilities to both boys and girls. Hostel accommodation is made purely on the basis of the candidate's merit and distance of his / her residence from the college. The College has 4 hostels, 2 for boys & 2 for girls. The boys' hostels have 40 seats while the girls' hostel has 50 plus.

Boys' Hostel : Bidhan Hostel & Sukanta Hostel. **Girls' Hostel :** Nivedita Hostel & Ma Sarada Hostel.

* All students residing in hostel must submit the seat rent of one year in advance. The mess system of each hostel is conducted by the students themselves under the supervision of the mess committee formed by the students.

CANTEEN : The College has two separate canteens – one for the students and the other for the college staff. The canteen of the college staff is situated behind the administrative building. The canteen of the students is within the **Sanskriti Bhavan**.

SEMINAR ROOM : There was a large Seminar Hall in the Banijya Bhavan. Recently one smart class room and virtual class room have been included. Different Seminars, workshops & symposia are conducted here both by the different departments & by the N.S.S. units of our college.

SPORTS DEPARTMENT: The college possesses a vast playground within its campus. Outdoor sports and tournaments are conducted on this ground. College cricket team plays in Inter College Tournaments and also in CAB tournaments. The local people also conduct various festivals and competitions like Bengal Yuva Utsab on our college ground. This year on concrete cricket pitch has been introduced for cricket practice.

N.C.C.: Since its inception the Department of N.C.C., functioning under the 4 Bengal Battalion (N.C.C.), has been providing our students with proper military training and discipline. Our college has the capacity of enrolling 150 cadets who can make use of their training in defence-related

jobs. They have also a scope to travel all over India and abroad, while undergoing the training programme, in addition to benefitting from personality development.

It is praiseworthy that the college NCC secured 1st place for the last two years during Republic Day Parade, organised by Sub Divisional Magistrate.

N.S.S.: There are three N.S.S. units in our college which inculcate a sense of social responsibility in our students. By taking part in several community programmees and awareness camps, the students become ideal citizens of our nation.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- The students must attend the classes regularly. Punitive meaures would be taken against the students with less attendance than what is stipulated by the B.U.
- Students must be serious about the internal assessments and should try to perform to their best.
- Students will not be awarded Internal Marks (15 Marks) unless they attend classes and internal assessments regularly. Students will not be allowed to appear at Final Semester Examination of the University if they do not secure qualifying marks at Internal Assessment.
- Tuition fees must be submitted in time.
- Students should behave politely inside the college campus and elsewhere.
- Students should actively participate in different seminars, symposia, workshops, social functions etc. conducted by the college.
- Students should co-operate with each teacher and non-teaching staff and help the college function smoothly.
- Students must be personally present in the college to collect their admit cards, marksheets & graduation certificates & they must also produce the documents for collecting the same.

The required documents are as follows :

For admit cards : acknowledgement card, registration certificate, library card & Library Clearance Certificate.

For mark-sheets : admit card.

For Graduation Certificates : registration certificate, admit card and final Mark-sheet.

- Loitering or littering in the college campus is strictly prohibited.
- Punctuality must be maintained in all matters, especially in class examination attendance.
- The College Notice Board must be followed daily.
- Once a student has taken admission in the college his / her Admission Fees will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- It is mandatory for the students, studying Geography (H/G), to participate in the departmental excursion. The expenses are to be borne by the student himself / herself.
- Wearing of college Identity Card is must for every student.



Rules and Regulations Regarding Fees :

- 1. Acknowledgement Card must be shown at the time of receiving Registration Card, Admit Card, Marksheet and any type of certificate.
- 2. Fees are to be submitted on the 1st day of a month. All arrear fees for an academic session (including fees of Hostel boarder) must be paid before Test or Annual Examination. The defaulters will not be able to appear in the Examination. Restoration fees of Rs. 50 with arrear fees and a fine of Rs. 10 per month are to be submitted if the fees are not submitted timely.
- 3. If the card is lost a new card will be issued on payment of Rs. 10.
- 4. All payment records are to be supplemented with receipts from the cash counter.
- 5. Important documents will be given only to bonafide students.

APPROACH OF AKPC MAHAVIDYALAYA TOWARDS RAGGING

AKPC Mahavidyalaya has accepted the guideline passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in connection with the judgement in Civil writ petition No. 656 of 1998 filed by Vishwa Jagriti Mission Vs Central Government and others.

The Mahavidyalaya has also accepted the West Bengal Prohibition of Ragging in Educational Institutions ACT. 2000 (W.B. Act XIII of 2000) which, inter alia, contained the following provisions (for details The Calcutta Gazette', Extraordinary, published by Authority on Monday, May 29, 2000 may be seen).

- "Ragging means the doing of any act which causes, or is likely to cause any physical, psychological or physiological harm or apprehension or shame or embarrassment to a student and includes (a) Teasing or abusing or playing practical joke on, or causing hurt to any student, or (b) asking any student to do any act or perform anything, which he / she would not in the ordinary course, be willing to do or perform.
- 2. Prohibition of Ragging (a) Ragging within an educational institution is hereby prohibited. (b) No person shall participate in, abet or propagate, ragging in any educational institution.
- 3. Penalty for Ragging (a)Expulsion from the educational institution, if found guilty on enquiry by the institution against a complaint lodged by any other student. (b) Imprisonment of either description upto two years or fine upto five thousand rupees or both. (c) Any student convicted under 3(b) shall be dismissed from the educational institution in which he / she has been pursuing his / her studies for the time being and shall not be readmitted to that educational institution.

The college has further accepted in principle that each and every student of the college shall be duty-bound during the entire period of studentship with the college to immediately report to the principal and any member of this committee if any ragging is noticed either in college hostel or on college campus.

মহাবিদ্যালয়ের ভিত্তিপ্রস্তর স্থাপন উপলক্ষ্যে প্রকাশিত স্মরণিকার পুনর্মুদ্রণ অঘোরকামিনী প্রকাশচন্দ্র মহাবিদ্যালয়ের (কলেজের) ভিত্তিস্থাপন উৎসব

আরামবাগের ৭ মাইল পশ্চিমে এই সুভাষনগর। ইতিহাস-প্রসিদ্ধ দুইটি রাজপথ অহল্যাবাঈ রোড ও বর্ধমান-পুরী রোডের সঙ্গমস্থলে অবস্থিত এই ক্ষুদ্র গ্রামটি ১৯৩১ সালে নেতাজি সুভাষচন্দ্রের পুণ্য পাদস্পর্শে ধন্য হয়। সুভাষচন্দ্র তখন কলিকাতা কর্পোরেশনের মেয়র। তিনি এই স্থানে দুইটি রাত্রি ডাঃ রাধাকৃষ্ণ পাল, এম. এল. এ.'র সহিত অতিবাহিত করেন। পুণ্যময় সেই দুইটি রাত্রির স্মৃতি বহন করে চলেছে এই সুভাষনগর।

৪ঠা জানুয়ারি ১৯৫৯ সন। সার্ধ শতাব্দী পরে এই স্থান ধন্য হয়ে উঠল বাংলার অপর একজন সুসন্তান ও ভারতের শ্রেষ্ঠ মনীষী ডাঃ বিধানচন্দ্র রায়ের পাদস্পর্শে। পুণ্যশ্লোক পিতৃদেব ও গরীয়সী জননীর স্মারক অঘোরকামিনী প্রকাশচন্দ্র মহাবিদ্যালয়ের ভিত্তি স্থাপিত হল। নতুন জীবনের স্পন্দন জাগল জনগণ মনে।

দশ সহস্রাধিক জনতা কর্তৃক মুখ্যমন্ত্রী ডাঃ বিধানচন্দ্র রায় সুভাষনগরে (আরামবাগ) বিপুলভাবে সম্বর্ধিত।

খাদ্যমন্ত্রী শ্রী প্রফুল্ল সেন ও প্রদেশ কংগ্রেস কর্ণধার সমভিব্যাহারে আগমন। অঘোরকামিনী প্রকাশচন্দ্র মহাবিদ্যালয়ের ভিত্তিপ্রস্তর স্থাপন।

পশ্চিমবাংলার মুখ্যমন্ত্রী ডাঃ বিধানচন্দ্র রায় আরামবাগ মণ্ডল কংগ্রেস কমিটির অধিবেশন সমাপনান্তে বাঁকুড়া যাইবার পথে খাদ্যমন্ত্রী শ্রী প্রফুল্লচন্দ্র সেন ও প্রদেশ কংগ্রেস কর্ণধার শ্রী অতুল্য ঘোষ সমভিব্যাহারে সুভাষনগরে উপনীত হন। সুভাষনগরে যাইবার পথে রাস্তায় রাস্তায় পত্রপুষ্পশোভিত তোরণদ্বারে স্থানীয় পল্লীবধূরা মঙ্গলঘট স্থাপিত করিয়া শঙ্খধ্বনি দ্বারা তাঁহাকে সাদর অভ্যর্থনা জানান। রাস্তায় দুই পার্শ্বে সারিবদ্ধভাবে দণ্ডায়মান বিশাল জনতা তাঁহাদের প্রিয় মহান নেতাকে দেখিবামাত্র জয়ধ্বনি করিয়া উঠে ও পুস্পস্তবক বর্ষণ করে। বেলা চারি ঘটিকায় সুভাষনগরে আসিবার পথে সুসজ্জিত প্রথম তোরণদ্বারে হাজার হাজার প্রতীক্ষমাণ জনতা ''বিধানচন্দ্র কি জয়'' ধ্বনিতে আকাশ বাতাস মুখরিত করিয়া তোলে। একুশটি তোপধ্বনি দ্বারা ডাঃ রায়ের শুভ পদার্পণ ঘোষণা করা হয় এবং সঙ্গে সঙ্গে প্রতিটি দ্বারে দণ্ডায়মান এক একটি ব্যান্ডবাদক ও ব্যাগপাইপ দল কর্তৃক ''জনগণমন'' জাতীয় সঙ্গীত গীত হইতে থাকে। সম্মুখে উন্মুক্ত প্রাঙ্গণে অপেক্ষমাণ প্রায় দশ সহস্রেরও অধিক এক বিশাল জনতা 'জয়তু বিধান', 'বিধানচন্দ্র কি জয়' ধ্বনিতে ডাঃ রায়কে সম্বর্ধনা জানান। অতঃপর এই বিশাল জনতার পক্ষ হইতে সুভাষনগরের প্রতিষ্ঠাতা আরামবাগের অপ্রতিদ্বন্দ্বী নেতা ডাঃ রাধাকৃষ্ণ পাল, এম. এল. এ., মহামান্য অতিথি ডাঃ রায়, খাদ্যমন্ত্রী শ্রী প্রফুল্ল সেন ও শ্রী অতুল্য ঘোষ প্রমুখ নেতৃবৃন্দকে স্বাগত জানান। ডাঃ রায় স্মিতহাস্যে গাড়ি হইতে অবতরণ করিয়া অপেক্ষমাণ জনতাকে দর্শনদান করেন। তাহার পর ডাঃ পাল মাননীয় নেতৃবৃন্দকে ডাঃ রায়ের স্বর্গাদপি গরীয়সী জননী অঘোরকামিনী ও পিতৃদেব পুণ্যশ্লোক প্রকাশচন্দ্রের নামাঙ্কিত প্রস্তাবিত মহাবিদ্যালয়ের ভিত্তিপ্রস্তর স্থাপনের জন্য সাদর আহ্বান জানাইলে ডাঃ রায় এক গুরুগস্তীর পরিবেশের মধ্যে উক্ত ভিত্তিপ্রস্তর স্থাপন করেন। সেই শুভ মুহূর্তে মঙ্গলকলস স্থাপিত হয়। পল্লীমায়েরা শঙ্খধ্বনি করেন এবং শাস্ত্রজ্ঞ পণ্ডিতগণ মন্ত্রোচারণ করেন। তৎপরে এই উৎসবমুখর ভিত্তিস্থাপন পর্ব সমাপনান্তে মাননীয় ডাঃ রায়কে প্রস্তাবিত অঘোরকামিনী প্রকাশচন্দ্র মহাবিদ্যালয়ের পক্ষ হইতে অভিনন্দনপত্র প্রদান করা হয় এবং সমাপ্তি সংগীত গীত হয়।

যে উন্মুক্ত প্রাঙ্গণে অঘোরকামিনী প্রকাশচন্দ্র মহাবিদ্যালয় প্রতিষ্ঠিত হইবে ও বেঙ্গাই উচ্চ বিদ্যালয়ের পুরাতন ও নবনির্মিত ভবন, ডাঃ পাল তাঁহার দৃষ্টিগোচরে আনেন। ছাত্রাবাসের অভাব

হেতু দুরাগত ছাত্রগণের অধ্যয়নকার্যে নানারূপ বাধাবিদ্ধের কথাও তিনি ডাঃ রায়ের নিকট উল্লেখ করেন। অতঃপর ডাঃ পাল এই স্থানের ঐতিহ্যময় ইতিহাস ডাঃ রায়ের নিকট ব্যক্ত করেন। ইতিহাস প্রসিদ্ধ অহল্যাবাঈ রোড ও বর্ধমান-পুরী রোডের সঙ্গমস্থলে এই স্থান অবস্থিত। বৃত্তাকারে এক মাইলের মধ্যে প্রাকৃতিক পরিবেশ স্থানটিকে বিদ্যাচর্চার উপযোগী করিয়া তুলিয়াছে। ডাঃ পাল ইহাও জানান যে খাদ্যমন্ত্রী মাননীয় শ্রী প্রফুল্লচন্দ্র সেন মহোদয় এই উচ্চ বিদ্যালয়ের সভাপতি ও সর্ববিষয়ে এই বিদ্যালয়কে তিনি সাহায্য করিতেছেন।

ডাঃ পালের অভাব অভিযোগের কথা ডাঃ রায় গভীর মনোনিবেশসহকারে শ্রবণ করেন। তারপর তিনি অতুল্যবাবু সমভিব্যাহারে বিষ্ণুপুরের পথে বাঁকুড়া যাত্রা করেন এবং মাননীয় প্রফুল্লবাবু আরামবাগ প্রত্যাগমন করেন।

ইতিমধ্যে ডাঃ রায়ের দর্শনাভিলামে চারিদিক হইতে এক বিপুল জনসমাগম হইতে থাকে। কিন্তু মাননীয় নেতা চলিয়া যাওয়ায় সকলের মধ্যে গভীর হতাশার সঞ্চার হয়। ডাঃ পাল সম্মুখস্থ বিদ্যালয় ভবনে ঝুলানো ডাঃ রায়ের বিরাট প্রতিকৃতির প্রতি সকলের দৃষ্টি আকর্ষণ করিয়া তাঁহার আদর্শকে অনুসরণ করিয়া চলিবার জন্য সকলকে আহ্বান জানান। তিনি বলেন যে এই সুভাষনগরে যে মহাবিদ্যালয়ের ভিত্তি স্থাপন করিয়া গেলেন তাহা যেন আদর্শ কলেজে পরিণত হয়। সমবেত জনতার কাছে তিনি এই শুভেচ্ছাই প্রার্থনা করেন। তিনি ঘোষণা করেন যে তাহা ছাড়াও এই অঞ্চল একটি L. C. কলেজ, মাতার নামে অঘোরকামিনী মাতৃসদন ও পিতার নামে প্রকাশচন্দ্র সেবায়তন প্রতিষ্ঠা করিবার চেষ্টা করিবেন। অর্থাৎ মাতা, পুত্র ও পিতার আদর্শকে এখানে চির জাগরক রাখিবার জন্য এই প্রতিষ্ঠানগুলি এখানে সদা বিরাজমান থাকিবে।

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
