



A) Objective of Cooperation

G) Settlement of Disputes

Any dispute concerning the interpretation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

H) Amendment

- a) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties, and such amendment shall form an integral part of this MOU.
- b) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGES BETWEEN

PURBASTHALI COLLEGE AND

AGHOREKAMINI PRAKASHCHANDRA MAHAVIDYALAYA

This Agreement is made in Purbasthali College between Purbasthali College (an affiliatedcollege under The University of Burdwan) and Aghorekamini Prakashchandra Mahavidyalaya (an affiliated college under The University of Burdwan). I. THE REPRESENTATIVES

III. APPLICATION AND ADMISSION

The Students who are willing to participate in the exchange program are required to formally apply to their respective Head of the institute (or other designated official). It is the duty of the home institute to nominate the students on the basis of a selection criteria determined by them and forward the list with necessary documents to the host institute within the stipulated time, if any. The host institute reserves the right to review the applications of the students/ list ofstudents and make the final decision concerning their admission.

IV. FEES AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Exchange students shall pay tuition fees to their home institute while tuition fees will be waived at the host institution. Neither institute shall charge exchange students for tuition or application fees. Exchange students may apply for available scholarships at the host institute. The host institute may collect certain mandatory fees from incoming students which are not required from outgoing students. All such fees will be specified in advance.

V. REGISTRATION AND RECORDS

All exchange students must be full-time registered student of the home institute. The records of the exchange students will be made considering them as regular students of the host institute. An official transcript of attendance and marks/grades will be sent to the head of the home institute on the completion of the period of exchange. Any academic credit that an exchange student receives from the host institute may be transferred back to the home institute in accordance with procedures determined by the home institute.

VI. STUDENT OBLIGATIONS

Exchange students will be responsible for ensuring their own transportation arranged either individually or by the home institute, and the host institute is neither liable to give travel expenses to them nor responsible for providing financial aid for any purpose to an exchange student. It is the responsibility of the exchange students to secure their own housing accommodations, if required, however, on request of the particular student, the host institute mayprovide assistance in locating appropriate housing facility. The host institute reserves the right to dismiss/ prohibit any

Sri Ramkrishna Sarada Vidyamahapitha, Kamarpukur, Hooghly (here afterwards SRSVM) and Aghorekamini Prakashchandra Mahavidyalaya, Bengai, Hooghly (here afterwards AKPCM) wish to initiate collaboration in different disciplines through various programmes supported by the two colleges.

SRSVM and AKPCM recognize their strengths in education in the discipline of Science and Arts and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in academic as well as cultural cooperation.

Therefore, SRSVM and AKPCM agree to establish a programme for academic and cultural cooperation in areas of mutual interest, and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

A. Objectives

The goal of this cooperation is to foster collaboration, provide opportunity for inter-college exchange of experience, and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts and frequent interactions aiming at mutual benefits for both the institutions. SRSVM and AKPCM agree to explore the possibility of engaging in the following modes of collaboration:

- a. Provision of consultancy on the campus development of SRSVM and AKPCM by experts of both the Colleges;
- Exchange of information on teaching, learning materials and other literature relevant to their academic programmes;
- Organization of seminars, conferences, workshops and short-term educational programmes jointly
 on topics of mutual interest, while extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate
 therein;

- d. Joint proposal in training programmes sponsored by funding agencies, while extending invitation to each other's faculty to participate therein;
- e. Organization of Cultural Competition jointly, exchange of students efficient in this sphere and also organization of Games' Competition and cooperation in this regard from both ends.

B. Joint sponsored Development and Consulting

- i. SRSVM and AKPCM agree to invite faculty members from the other institution to participate in development programmes of mutual interest. It is anticipated that the terms and conditions for such participation would be worked out by mutual agreement between the faculty member(s) and the institution extending such an invitation.
- Further, SRSVM and AKPCM agree to jointly identify and pursue opportunities for ii. formulation and submission of training programmes for possible funding by State or Central agencies, if needed.
- It is foreseen that when a faculty member visits a partner institution on invitation, such a visit iii. will be subject to the regulations of the individual partner institution.

C. Exchange of Faculty

SRSVM and AKPCM agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculties from the two colleges. Specifically, the two colleges would encourage members of their faculty to undertake short visits or take up fixed term assignments on visiting faculty.

D. Students Exchange

SRSVM and AKPCM agree to discuss the means for enabling the exchange of students between two colleges. Each exchanged student would be selected by mutual agreement and in accordance to the regulations of the partner institutions.

E. Tenure and Termination

This MoU will take effect from the date it is signed by Principal/Teacher-in-charge of the two colleges. It will remain valid for a period of five years. This MoU will be reviewed after three years; the terms of this MoU may be amended by mutual written agreement prior to the date of review. Any extension to this MoU will be formally approved in writing by the parties. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice to the other institution six months in advance. Once terminated, neither SRSVM nor AKPCM will be responsible for any losses, financial or otherwise, which the other institutions may suffer. However, SRSVM and AKPCM will ensure that all activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully.

F. Arbitration clause

If there be a dispute relating to any aspect of academic and cultural co-operation, Principal/Teacherin-charge of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect, and shared responsibility.



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Aghorekamini Prakashchandra Mahavidyalaya Bengai, Hooghly

Netaji Mahavidyalaya (NM), Arambagh and Aghorekamini Prakashchandra Mahavidyalaya (AKPCM), Bengai, both affiliated to The University of Burdwan, linked by common academic interests, wish to initiate collaborations and exchanges in fields of shared interest and expertise in different disciplines through various programmes supported by the two colleges. Both NM & AKPCM recognise their strengths and their mutual interest in engaging themselves in Academic, Social & Cultural co-operation. The actives undertaken pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) are based on a spirit of cooperation and reciprocity that is intended to be of mutual benefit of both the institutions.

1. Purpose:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) serves as a written understanding of agreed upon principles between NM & AKPCM concerning a set of general academic objectives. This is a non-binding agreement and is intended to clarify the nature and extent of the harmonizing activities that might be undertaken for the mutual benefit of the two institutions. Each institution will be responsible for managing its own expenses and also sharing the same, when necessary. Commitments of specific institutional resources, personnel, space, facilities, or any other academic or intellectual activities considered hereunder may or may not be beyond the scope of this MOU to the extent that the implementation of any agreed upon activity requires a commitment of resources, personnel, credit-bearing coursework, or intellectual property. A supplementary agreement will be negotiated and approved by the two parties before work on any of the projects can commence.

2. Objectives, Scope, and Major Activities:

The goal of this co-operation is to encourage and foster collaboration, provide opportunity for inter college exchange of experience and to facilitate advancement of knowledge on the basis of reciprocity, best efforts and frequent interactions to promote mutual benefits of both the institutions. Both the institutions agree to encourage their mutual development by exploring the possibility of engaging in

the following modes of collaborations.

- Visits and formal exchanges of faculty, scholars and administrators in specific areas of education, research and outreach respectively.
- Explore the possibility of training through library as well as laboratory resources.
- Organize joint conferences, symposia, workshop or other scientific meeting on subjects of mutual interest.
- Exchange of academic information and learning materials.
- Organise cultural competitions and sports meet jointly and exchange students efficient in these spheres.
- Explore the possibilities of developing joint research programs and collaborations.
- Other exchange and cooperation programs such as extension activities to which both the institutions

3. Responsibilities of the Institutions:

The two institutions identify that the execution of any agreed upon activity will depend upon the interests and expertise of the individuals involved and availability of financial resources, space and other resources. Accordingly, the functioning of any exchange and cooperative program based on this MOU shall be conferred and determined between the two institutions. It is also expected that both the institutions will work at per with all the applicable policies of the Govt. of India, State Govt. and University legislations.

4. Duration and Option to Amend, Extend or Terminate:

This MOU will become effective from the date on which it is signed by the authorities of both the institutions. The agreement will remain in effect for five years from the date of signature given below, and may be renewed or amended by mutual agreement of the institutions. The institutions should agree to periodically review the activities undertaken and the progress made and to consult concerning amendments, renewal or termination of this MoU. Either authority may terminate this MoU at any time by providing written notice of such termination to the other authority, at least 3 months in advance. Once terminated, neither institutions will be responsible for any losses financial or otherwise, which the other institution may suffer. However, both the institutions will ensure that all the activities in progress are allowed to complete successfully before termination.

5. General Terms:

This MoU is not intended to and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents. Nothing in this MoU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the two parties. Neither party will use the name of the other, either expressly or by implication, in any publicity, solicitation or advertisement without written approval of the other party to this MoU.
