## **Best Practice 2**

Title: Distribution of Saplings and Medicinal Plants among Students and Local People

## **Objective:**

- To create awareness among students and local people about climate change and the need of afforestation.
- To create an ecological balance at the local level.
- To maintain the oxygen level in the local atmosphere by contributing towards increment of carbon sink.
- To make students and the local people aware of the medicinal value of plants.

**Context**: Since environmental pollution has snowballed into a global concern, it is our duty to increase green cover in the environment as much as possible.
