HISTORY OF NATIONAL CADET CORPS

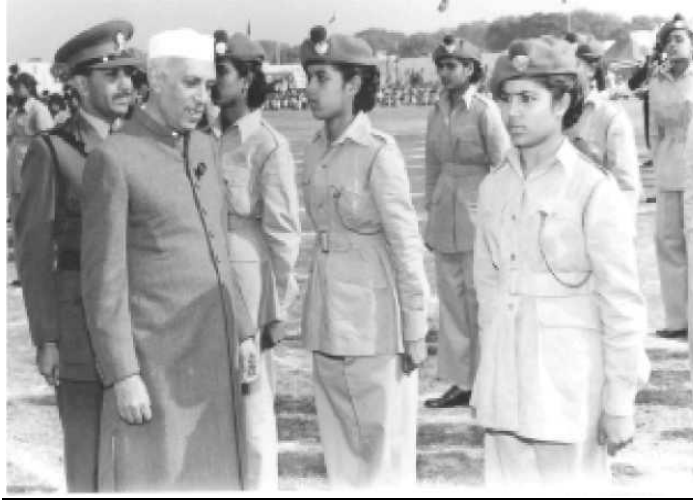
NCC was first started in 1666 in Germany. The British Government desired to impart Army Training to the students of Indian Universities so that they may get good officers for their forces. To keep in view, they started **University Corps (UC)** in 1917. In 1920, the **University Corps (UC)** was replaced by the **University Training Corps (UTC)**. Later on during 1942 it was rechristened into **University Officers Training Corps (UOTC)**. However, this organization has a limited sphere and activities.

It was noticed during the **Second World War (1914-18)** that this University Officers Training Corps (UOTC) could not fulfill its mission. Admitting this fact, The Govt. of India appointed a National Cadet Corps Committee to impart training to youth in future during 1946 under the chairmanship of **Pt. Hridayanath Kunzru**. After deeply studying army training of the developed countries of the World, this committee has submitted a detailed report to The Govt. of India during March 1947. The Govt. of India accepted the recommendations of this committee and prepared a bill which was passed in the Parliament during April 1948 and was made **National Cadet Corps Act 1948** (Parliament Act No. XXXI of 1948). Thus the NCC was raised on **15th July 1948** in schools, colleges and universities of India.

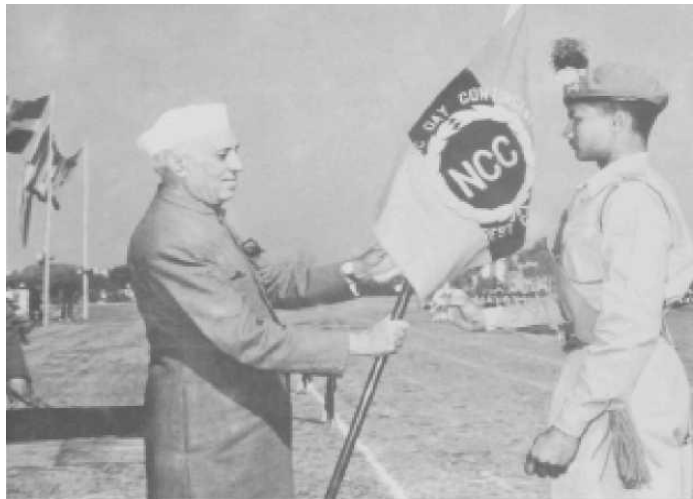
To widen the scope of the NCC training, a **Girls Division** in July 1949, **Air Wing** was added on 01st April 1950 with one Air Squadron each at Bombay and Calcutta. **Navy Wing** in July 1952 was established. In 1960 **NCC Rifles** was imparted. After 1962 (Chinese aggression), during July 1963 NCC was made compulsory to all the healthy students of colleges & universities of India. Later on 2nd April 1964, the **NCC** and the **NCC Rifles** were merged and compulsory training of students was abolished in 1968. During Indo-Pakistani war of 1965 & Bangladesh-Pakistani war of 1971, NCC cadets were second line of defence. From 1948 to the present day, it is headed by The Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India.

The motto of NCC is 'Unity & Discipline' which was adopted on 23 Dec 1957. The need for having motto for the Corps was discussed in the 11th Central Advisory Committee (CAC) meeting held on 11 August 1978. The mottos suggested were “Duty and Discipline”; “Duty, Unity and Discipline”; “Duty and Unity”; “Unity and Discipline”. The final decision for selection of “Unity and Discipline” as Motto for the NCC was taken in the 12th CAC meeting held on 12 October 1980.

NCC is an inter-service organization; therefore, its flag is divided into three (03) equal straight strips. NCC Flag contains NCC Crest in gold in the middle, with the letters “NCC” encircled by a wreath of Seventeen (17) Lotuses with a background in Red, Deep Blue and Light Blue. In this, Red strip is on the left side depicts the Army, Deep Blue is in the middle depicts the Navy whereas Light Blue is on the right side depicts the Air Force. The Seventeen (17) Lotuses represent the Seventeen (17) State Directorates. “Unity and Discipline” (Ekta aur Anushasan) written in Hindi is written at the bottom of the NCC Flag.

FLAG OF NATIONAL CADET CORPS



The NCC flag for various units of the NCC was first introduced in 1951. The flag was of same pattern, colour and size as was used by various regiments of the Army. The only difference was that it had the NCC badge and unit designation placed in the centre. Later on it was felt that the flag should be in keeping with the inter-service character of the Corps. In 1954 the existing tricolour flag was introduced. The three colours in the flag depict the three services of the Corps, red for the Army, deep blue for the Navy and light blue for the Air Force. The letters NCC and the NCC crest in gold in the middle of the flag encircled by a wreath of lotus, give the flag a colourful look and a distinct identity.



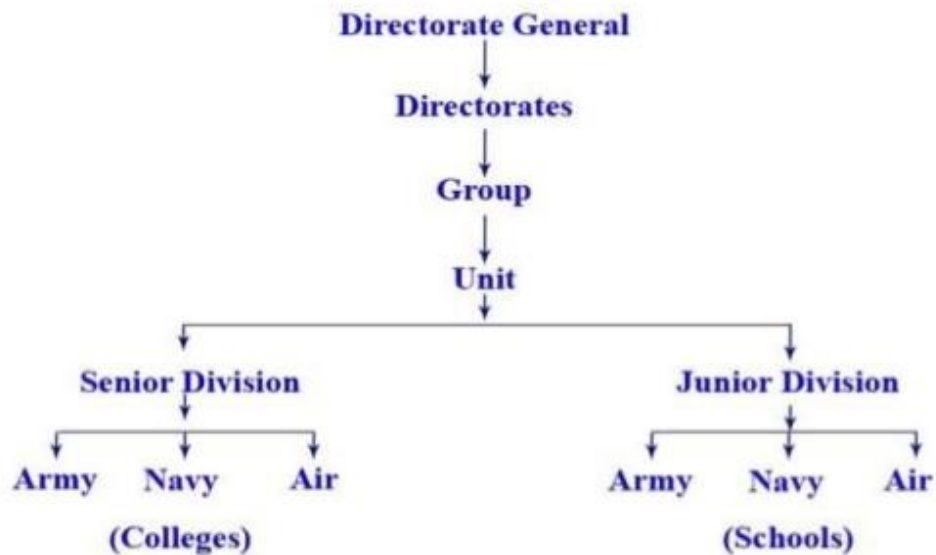

The National Cadet Corps Directorate was established under the Ministry of Defence, Govt. of India during 1948. At Headquarters level, the NCC is headed by a Director General with the rank of lieutenant-general. He is assisted by two Additional Director Generals (ADG) A and B of two-star rank (major-general, rear-admiral or air vice-marshal). Five Brigadier level officers and other civil officials also assist him. The Headquarters is located in New Delhi. There are 17 Directorates located in the state capitals headed by an officer of the rank of Maj Gen from the three Services. Depending upon the size of the state and growth of NCC in the states, Directorates have up to 14 Group Headquarters under them through which they exercise their command and control of the organization in the state. Each group is headed by an officer of the rank of Brigadier or equivalent known as Group Commander. Each NCC Group Headquarters control 5-7 units (Bns) commanded by Colonel/Lt.Col or equivalent. Each Battalion consists of companies which are commanded by the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of the rank of Lieutenant to Major. In all there are 95 Group Headquarters in the country who exercise control over a network of 667 Army Wing Units (including technical and girls unit), 60 Naval Wing Units and 61 Air Squadrons. There are two training establishments namely Officers Training Academy (OTA), Kamptee, Nagpur, Maharashtra and Women Officers Training Academy (WOTA), Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh. The Defence Secretary, Ministry of Defence is the overall in charge who is responsible to the Govt. of India for efficient functioning of the NCC. Today its sanctioned strength stands up to 5 Lacks for Senior Division (SD) and 8 Lacks for Junior Division (JD). Presently a total of 13 Lacks cadets spread all over India.

Regular officers

The NCC directorates are headed by service officers of the rank of Lieutenant General and equivalent; Group Headquarters are headed by service officers of the rank of Brigadier and equivalent, and Units are headed by service officers of the rank of Colonel (TS) or equivalent. They are responsible for proper training, planning and execution of NCC activities.

Whole Time Lady Officers (WTLO)

A cadre of Whole Time Lady Officers (WTLO) with cadre strength 110 officers has been sanctioned in 1995. They are to be commissioned partly through departmental channel and partly through UPSC in a phased manner.

Associate NCC Officer (ANO)

ANO is an important link in the NCC organization between the Battalion and the cadets. As a matter of fact, ANO is the feeder node of NCC since he / she is the one who is in direct contact with the cadets all throughout the year. There are two training establishments namely Officers Training Academy, Kamptee and Women Officers Training Academy, Gwalior. These two institutions train the school and college teachers selected to head the company/troop. Courses in these institutions range from 21 days to 90 days in duration.

Associate NCC officers are given following ranks according to their seniority and their training.

NCC DRESS OUT

Army cadets wear khaki uniform. Naval cadets wear white uniform of Navy. Air Force cadets wear light blue grey (LBG) uniform. The uniform is compulsory on all the occasions.

Cadets from SD boys in Army wing wear khaki full sleeve shirt and trousers & cadets from JD wear khaki shirt & khaki shorts. Girl cadets from SW & JW both wear khaki full sleeve shirt and trousers. Cadets from SD boys in Naval wing wear white half sleeve shirt and white trousers & JD boys wear half sleeve white shirt and white shorts. Girls from Naval wing SW & JW wear white half sleeve shirt and trousers. Cadets from SD boys in Air wing wear light blue half sleeve shirts and trousers & JD cadets wear light blue half sleeve shirts and trousers. Girls from SW and JW wear light blue half sleeve shirts and trouser. In addition to these SW & JW cadets wear white salwar and kamiz during activities other than parade. Rifle green beret is compulsory for all the cadets except Sikh cadets who wear rifle green turban. For physical training cadets wear brown canvas shoes and for drills black leather shoes called D.M.S (Drill March Shoes). Woolen vests are compulsory in cold areas whose colour varies khaki for army, dark blue for navy, and black for air. (Even NCC cadets wear INDIAN ARMY uniforms sometimes.)

TRAININGS, CAMPS & ACTIVITIES OF NCC

TRAININGS - Total training period for SD and SW is 3 years with a permissible extension of 1 year & training period for JD & JW is of 2 years. Every cadet of the Senior or Junior Division has to undergo service training for a period of at least 4 hours/week during the training year. Every cadet of the Senior and Junior Division has undergo service training for a minimum period of 75% of total hours during the annual college and school session. Every cadet (in case of JD, who has completed one full year of training and is in his second year) attends an Annual Training Camp of 10 days, also known as Combined Annual

Training Camp(CATC). For SD/SW the duration is usually for up to 30 days. At the end of the training camp, the cadets receive a certificate of successful completion.

INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING – It is conducted by Associate NCC Officers and Armed Forces personnel at Colleges and Schools. It is the mainstay of NCC training. The syllabus comprises Common Subjects and Service Subjects in the ratio 70:30. While the Senior Wing/Division training is for three years and has 300 periods the Junior Wing/Division training is for two years and encompasses 240 periods of training. The training year is from 01 Apr to 31 March. Training schedules planned for cadets ensure that the optimum benefits of the organisation reach maximum number of cadets. Emphasis is on practical training. Case study method of instruction, wherever possible, is made to facilitate active participation and better assimilation.

(b) Institutional training includes basic military training to the cadets as part of the curriculum and prepares them to join in the Armed Forces. It is conducted with the following specific purposes:-

(i) Firstly, to expose young cadets to a `regimental way of life' which is essential to inculcate in them the values of discipline, duty, punctuality, orderliness, smartness, respect for the authorities, correct work ethos, and self- confidence.

(ii) Secondly, to generate interest in cadets by including and laying emphasis on those aspects of Institutional Training which attract young cadets into the NCC and provides them an element of thrill and excitement.

(iii) Thirdly, to inculcate Defence Services work ethos that is characterised by hard work, sincerity of purpose, honesty, ideal of selfless service, dignity of labour, secular outlook, comradeship, spirit of adventure and sportsmanship.

CAMP TRAINING - Camp training is the practical manifestation of institutional training. The basic aim of Camps is to introduce cadets to a regimented way of life and helps in developing team work, leadership qualities, self-confidence, self-reliance and dignity of labour in the cadets. The cadets are exposed to the excitement of camp life where they apply the theoretical knowledge that they had gained in Institutional Training. It is mandatory for Junior Division/ Junior Wing cadets to attend at least one camp and Senior Division/ Senior Wing cadets to attend a minimum of two camps during the period of their enrolment. NCC conducts over 1450 camps annually at an average frequency of more than 100 camps in a month. Each NCC Camp is structured for approximately 400 - 600 cadets with Instructional staff comprising three to four officers and 15-20 Associate NCC Officers (ANOs)/ Permanent Instructors (PI) Staff/ Whole Time Lady Officers (WTLOs)/ Girl Cadet Instructors (GCIs). More than 8 lakhs cadets attend these camps each year. Republic Day Camp is the acme of NCC training and is conducted in January every year.

Certificates & Examination

There are Three Certificates in NCC. Below describes about it from lower value to higher value:-

- Certificate – **“A”**: It is only for JD/ JW cadets of NCC. Cadets of class VIII & IX after passing those classes, it can be obtained. The candidate must have attended a minimum 75% of total training periods laid down in the syllabus for the first & second years of JD/JW NCC (All Wings). The candidate must have attended any one Camp.
- Certificate – **“B”** : It can be written by SD / SW cadets of NCC, after class 10 & those studying for +2 & College level. In the second year of training they can appear for the same. The candidate must have attended a minimum 75% of total training periods laid down in the syllabus for the first & second years of SD/SW NCC (All Wings). He/she must have attended any one Camp. Cadets possessing 'A' certificate will be awarded 10 bonus marks.
- Certificate – **“C”** : It is the Most important certificate for NCC cadet. It can be written in the 3rd year of training in the 3rd year of degree course / those having 'B' certificate can write it in the first year after his +2 and in the 1st year of degree by SD / SW cadets only. The candidate must have attended a minimum 75% of total training periods. He/She must possess 'B' certificate with compulsory have attended any two Camps.

Grading in Certificate

Three certificates with Grade A, B & C are awarded to the NCC cadets after passing the concerned Examination. The best certificate is C which has the highest value. (i) A cadet has to obtain 45% marks in each paper & 50% marks in the aggregate to pass the examination. Grading is based on total marks obtain will be awarded as follows.

- Grading 'A' - Cadets obtaining 80% marks and above.
- Grading 'B' - Cadets obtaining 65% marks and above but below 80%.
- Grading 'C' - Cadets obtaining 50% marks and above but below 65%.
- Fail - Cadets obtaining less than 45% in any paper or less than 50% in aggregate.

Training of Trainers

- **Officers Training Academy (OTA) Kamptee, Nagpur, Maharashtra** : NCC OTA was established on 01 Mar 1957 and formally inaugurated on 06 May 1957 by the then Dy Def Minister Sardar Surjit Singh Manjithia. Imparting training to Associate NCC Officers (ANOs), JCOs and NCOs posted to NCC is the principal task of this Academy. The types of courses being conducted by OTA Kamptee are :- *(PICS OF OTA)*

- **Women Officers Training Academy (WOTA) Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh**: The Girls wing for Pre-Commission Training for Lady ANOs which was shifted to Gwalior is a premier Women Officer Training Academy. The same training was conducted there for Lady ANOs, Girls Cadets Instructors (GCIs) and Whole Time Lady Officers (WTLOs).

HISTORY OF NCC DEPARTMENT, COY – 4/2, AGHOREKAMINI PRAKASHCHANDRA MAHAVIDYALAYA, BENGAI, HOOGHLY.

The Department of NCC, coy-4/2 of this college started its journey from the year 1967. In the year 1967, Prof. Sukumar Banerjee went to Officer Training School (OTS) at Kamptee, Nagpur. He was commissioned as 2nd Lieutenant and running this NCC unit of this college very successfully. In the year 1991, Sri Swapan Kumar Ghosh was taken charge of this department after the retirement of Prof. Banerjee. But after continuation of 29 years in 1996, this Department was not running and being closed by 4 Bengal Battalion due to some unavoidable circumstances.

In the year 2008, with the continuous efforts and constant Endeavour by the then Principal Dr. Saroj Sinha, this Department was again opened in a grand majestic manner by the then Commanding Officer Col B C Rai under the 4 Bengal Battalion, Purta Bhavan, Burdwan, under Burdwan Group. Prof. Rajkumar Modak was taken charge as CareTaker Officer in NCC Department from that time and in a discipline way Prof. Modak was running this Department. In the year 2010 Prof. Rajkumar Modak was selected for commissioned course at OTA (Officer Training Academy), Kamptee, Nagpur, Maharashtra. But he was severely injured at the Training Academy and was return to his unit without completing the three months course.

In the month of June 2011, the name of Prof. Rajnarayan Chaudhuri was nominated by the then Governing Body of the college and approved by the then Commanding Officer of 4 Bengal Battalion Col Khan Mahamood . Prof. Chaudhuri was asking for taking charge as Care Taker Officer of the NCC Department of this college from 03 June 2011. And after that Prof. Chaudhuri was undergoing an interview at NCC Club House, Park Street, Kolkata and selected by the expert committee to go for the Pre Commissioned Course (PRCN) from 02nd July 2012 to 29th September 2012 at Officer Training Academy (OTA), Kamptee, Nagpur, Maharashtra. He was commissioned on 03 October 2012 as **Lieutenant** by the Ministry Of Defence, Govt. of India.

Few years after commissioned as Lieutenant, he was undertaking the Refresher Course to Officer Training Academy (OTA), Kamptee, Nagpur, Maharashtra on 31 March 2014 to 26 April 2014 for promotion of his rank. After completing the Refresher Course very successfully, he was commissioned as **Captain** on 03 October 2020. Under his able guidance, training and discipline, many cadets achieved their destination and deployed in various Govt. sectors all over India. A cadet who achieved Governor's Medal in 2023 after completing the Republic Day Parade 2023 at New Delhi, India is the example of his worthy leadership.

Right now, Captain Chaudhuri is continuing his service at his best to prepare the best cadets out of this society.
